

The message of the Trust is very clear. Service is endless. Kanara Welfare Trust is nothing but humanism of Dr. Dinkar Desai personified. Thousands of beneficiaries of the trust living in different places of the District and also outside look up to it with a deep sense of gratitude and wish.

Magnificent buildings, laboratories, libraries and beautiful gardens hold out a proof to the development and activities of the Trust. It should be remembered that the Trust is something more than a collection of bricks and stones. It is a living and growing organisation. Thousands of well-wishers, philanthropic donors, admirers and not to speak of countless beneficiaries constitute this mighty organisation.

By and large, Kanara Welfare Trust has been able to achieve what is contained in the preamble. Observing the manifold activities of the Trust, an eminent person exclaimed, "The Trust by its significant service has almost established a University in the District of North Kanara". Today we have a network of Institutions all over the District. It has to its credit 45 Institutions – 4 Degree colleges, 2 PG Centres, 6 Junior Colleges, 17 High Schools, 10 Primary & Pre-Primary Schools, 2 Tailoring Schools, 2 Music Schools and 2 Computer Centres. It was started with a meagre amount of Rs.6000/- collected by the Raith Community and now the assets are more than 15 crores excluding the land. The family of the Trust is growing day by day and there has been a significant increase in the number of students. Total enrolment is about 12000. All these have been possible because of the careful and judicious management of the Trust.

Saga of Kanara Welfare Trust is the saga of sacrifice of one individual – Dr. Dinkar Desai – who was our great torch bearer and lent us all help to keep this torch burning and spread the light in to the farthest corners of the District. Since the death of Dr. Desai in 1982, the present Chairman, Shri S.P.Kamat is contributing his mite to keep the torch bright and blazing aloft. He is ably assisted by the other Trustees. The Trust has been conducting fresh and feasible experiments in the welfare of the people of this district from time to time under his dynamic leadership.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE TRUST

- a. To carry out and promote educational, cultural, social and material advancement of the people, particularly of the backward and poorer classes within the District of Uttar Kannada.
- b. To impart education and knowledge, especially by establishing and maintaining educational institutions and hostels, including agricultural schools, teacher training schools and schools for imparting technical education.
- c. To establish Institutions of higher learning in medical, engineering, pharmaceutical and in any other branch of social relevance.
- d. To establish hospitals, dispensaries with emphasis on holistic treatment.
- e. To publish books of literary merit.
- f. To set up old-age and destitute homes, orphanages and / or to encourage and help Institutions / individuals engaged in similar pursuits for the benefit of the public at large.
- g. To undertake research and development in any field which may be conducive for the general welfare of the public at large.
- h. To help preservation and protection of the environment and forests.
- i. To evolve models / systems of bio-conservation, Indian and world eco-structure, etc.
- j. To establish laboratories, training centres, knowledge centres, etc.
- k. To encourage the learning and spreading of Indian culture and heritage, such as music, fine art, literature, etc.
- l. For the furtherance of the objectives to maintain liaison with other professional institutions and training bodies in various parts of the world.
- m. To act in collaboration with Central and State Governments and other bodies or appropriate agencies for formulation and executions of the project which would further the objectives as set out above and to accept any grants or funds and donations for the said purpose.
- n. To act as a clearing house of information for various individuals, institutions or other persons interested in the activities listed above.
- o. To promote the publication of literature pertaining to the objectives and the activities contemplated herein.
- p. To establish and maintain liaison with other associations or recognized bodies in India or abroad whose objectives are in keeping with the objectives of this Trust.
- q. To purchase, to take on lease or in exchange or otherwise acquire, hold, possess and dispose of any movable or immovable property which may be deemed necessary, expedient or desirable in the larger interest of the Trust and its objectives.
- r. To enter into arrangements / amalgamation with any other associations, institutions, societies or trusts having similar objectives as of this Trust.

- s. To borrow money or receive deposits upon such terms and conditions as the Board shall deem necessary or expedient for achieving the objectives of this Trust.
- t. To give any donations or aid to any other deserving, charitable institutions or to a cause or to any needy / deserving person / persons as may be found suitable by the Board.
- u. To undertake the acts of whatever nature which are consistent with the objectives herein and / or which may promote the objectives herein, and are also conducive for the welfare and well-being of the people at large.

REGISTRATION OF THE TRUST DEED

Kanara Welfare Trust was registered on 29-09-1953 under the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1951 and was subsequently amended as per the resolution dated 13-12-1981.

The Bombay Public Trust Act, 1951, under which the Trust was registered has ceased to exist on account of its repeal by the new Karnataka Act – Karnataka Hindu Religion and Charitable Endowments Act. The new Act however, does not cover the purely charitable trusts such as Kanara Welfare Trust. As such, under the revised circumstances, Trust did not have the status of a registered trust. On account of this situation, the Govt. had been insisting to have the Trust registered under any other appropriate enactment. Presently, again it was not possible to register a trust like Kanara Welfare Trust under any other Act. Under the circumstances, it had become incumbent to have the Trust Deed itself registered under the provisions of either the Trust Act or Registration Act.

The Trust Deed was created in 1953 with certain specific objectives. However, over the years the scope of activities of the Trust having increased manifold in the process, it was deemed appropriate to add few more objectives to the original list of objectives. Similarly, it has become important to associate with other organizations in the process of achieving the objectives of the Trust. This contingency was also provided in the deed.

Moreover, it was deemed appropriate to approximately structure the deed consistent with the requirement of law. Accordingly, the Board of Trustees unanimously decided to incorporate the above changes in the original Trust Deed. The incorporated changes which do not in any way vary the original objectives or the basic structures of the Trust were reckoned and duly amended for the Trust Deed to come into effect immediately.

The said deed was registered before the registering authority, i.e. The Sub-Registrar's Office, Ankola on 6th July 2019. All the Trustees were present to render their signature and biometric details required for the registration.

The Trust Deed under registration no. AKL-4-00014-2019-20 dated 6th July 2019 shall henceforth be quoted / submitted by the Trust Institutions as and when required by the concerned authorities.

IN-HOUSE PROGRAMS CONDUCTED DURING THE YEAR

ACADEMIC WORKSHOPS

1. ONE-DAY WORKSHOP ON COMMERCE & ECONOMICS

Divekar College of Commerce, Karwar, conducted a workshop on Commerce and Economics on 17th of November 2018 for the lecturers working in the Junior Colleges run by Kanara Welfare Trust.



Commerce: This session was managed by Shri R.G.Naik. He briefed on the topic "Issue and redemption of debenture".

Problems were discussed and solved on this chapter. Focus was mainly on how to teach the students and make it simple for them to understand. The session was winded up by clearing the doubts regarding the chapters on admission, retirement, dissolution of partners and non-profit organizations.

Economics: This session was conducted by Shri Shambu Bhat, Lecturer in Economics from Sirsi. Discussion was held on methods of measuring National Income and accounting. Problems were solved on derivation and numerical, money and banking, demand for money, money multiplication, determination of income and employment, investment function and geometric progression.

Discussion on practical oriented questions and one mark and two mark questions were discussed. Discussion on Model Question Paper was held.

2. TWO-DAY WORKSHOP FOR PHYSICAL EDUCATION TEACHERS

Under the present model of education, teachers need to be updated with the latest trends in teaching pattern. A general survey of our Trust Institutions has revealed that our teachers, especially those who teach Physical Education, need more guidance about the new sports and sports syllabus which are introduced in the curriculum. The same is true of every institution in the district and the state.

To enable the teachers to get acquainted with new innovations in the subject and teaching methodology, the Trust organized a workshop for Physical Education Teachers of the high

schools run by KWT and Karwar Education Society. Teachers from various High Schools in Ankola and Karwar were also invited to attend the workshop.

The subject of Physical Education (Theory and Practical) has been introduced as one of the subjects for High School students by the State Education Board since the past 4 years. This has led to increased demand for introducing various sport disciplines in all the schools. Games such as Handball and activities like Aerobics have already been included in the syllabus and games like Netball are in the process to be included. The main objective of the workshop was to give first-hand knowledge of these three sports to the participants.

The games of Handball and Netball are being played in most parts of Karnataka but are not yet prevalent in Uttar Kannada. Handball and Netball games are very simple, fast, small area games and require a very high degree of physical fitness. These games can also be used as lead up activities for Basketball as all these three games have many skills in common. The games mostly rely on speed, agility and explosive power and needs players who are lean, tall yet fast. Most of the children of Uttar Kannada are naturally gifted with these qualities, hence these games can be easily taught to them and popularized. Through this workshop the purpose was to introduce Handball and Netball games to the Physical Education Teachers and Directors of this region who can in turn motivate their students to take up these sports along with the other prevalent sports in this area.



The inauguration was followed by technical sessions. The resource persons for the respective sports, namely **Shri Sudheer Rao**, Lecturer, K.G.Nadgir College of Physical

Education, Dharwad, and **Shri M.M.Patil**, PE Instructor, MVAS School, Dharwad, addressed the physical education teachers on the rules, regulations and nuances of the game of Handball. Physical Directors working in the Trust - **Dr. B.R.Tole**, PE Director, Divekar College of Commerce, Karwar, and **Dr. Ashwin R.**, PE Director, Gokhale Centenary College, Ankola, also assisted in the technicalities of the game. Two teams of players were specially called from Dharwad to physically demonstrate the game at the workshop. After a couple of natural plays, the resource persons clarified the various aspects of the game by individual demonstration. Doubts and queries were cleared on the field and the participating physical education teachers also took part in playing the game.



The Netball game was discussed in detail and also demonstrated by the players on the playground. Queries were patiently addressed by all the resource persons.

The next day commenced early and the activity related to Aerobics was demonstrated by **Ms. Namita Sarang**, Fitness Instructor, Karwar, both theoretically and practically. She was ably assisted by some of her students. The participants joined in and thoroughly enjoyed the practical aerobics session.



At the valedictory function, the dignitaries who were present addressed the gathering and stressed on the importance of physical activity in the life of a student, especially during their growing age. They lamented that, nowadays, sports has taken a backseat and the parents pacify their children by letting them use mobile phones and other technical stuff instead of allowing them to bask in the sun and play. The physical education teachers were urged to take keen interest in their subject and strive to make sports exciting for the students so that more and more of them actively participate in the playground.



Shri S.P.Kamat, Chairman, Kanara Welfare Trust & Karwar Education Society, presided over the closing function. He appreciated that all the physical education teachers of Karwar and Ankola talukas were present in full attendance at the workshop. He congratulated **Dr. B.R.Tole** and **Dr. Ashwin R.** for reviving the enthusiasm and interest for new sports in this region. He said problems of the teachers which were expressed in the workshop are understandable and the Trust will strive to address them at its level and also urge the Department to take proper steps to see that the students are not deprived of quality education, be it academic or physical education. He assured that the various Institutions and man-power of the Trust will always be accessible to strengthen the teaching and student community of the Uttar Kannada District.

One commonly hears about Man's onslaught on the Nature, resulting in destruction of natural elements for one's own need, nay greed. The concern for the fellow human beings is marginal. Respect and love for the Nature and the environment is minimal. The Man tends to preoccupy himself in trying to only talk about this phenomenon at an intellectual level and not making a serious attempt to address the real problem. The World cannot be changed without bringing about a change at the level of Man. If human mind changes, the world will be reflected in its change and that's the only way to change the world and save it from the downward slide that it is presently experiencing. If Man can make a positive effort to supplement the Nature's inbuilt mechanism, the acceleration towards the upward trend would be easily gained.

An attempt was envisaged and initiated at a relatively small humble level to create a group of young Boys and Girls who were in their formative years of life preferably in the age group of 14-16, who could be oriented to become change makers for the world tomorrow. The target group is chosen from the student community studying in the 8th standard in the Secondary level of Education. The candidates are selected from schools spanning the entire length and breadth of the Uttar Kannada District.

The focus is on the behavioural pattern, values and inputs for spiritual growth of the selected students. Main emphasis is on inner change and the ability to do the right thing.

There is also a need to look at ourselves internally & accept ourselves as we are; and at the same time to accept and respect others as they are. Change can happen only when one gains man-making knowledge and experience. And this is what the project – Change Makers for a Better Tomorrow strives to achieve.



These selected students are brought together every 3 months for special camps wherein they are imparted with thought-provoking and holistic training from various experts from different fields. Initiated in 2007-2008, four batches (of 3 years each) of the project have already been completed. The selection process for the fifth batch will begin shortly.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR EDUCATION

This project provides financial assistance to those who, due to lack of financial resources, are deprived of pursuing higher education. Every year, nearly 500 students are awarded with a scholarship amount of Rs.3000/- each. The beneficiaries are mainly from low income groups but diverse communities such as farmers, labourers, fishermen, etc. The Trust and Kruger Foundation believe that no deserving meritorious student should be deprived of higher education due to lack of financial resources. More than 3000 students studying across 160+ Colleges in the district have benefitted from this scheme since 2012-2013. Scholarships worth more than Rs.92 lakhs have been disbursed till date.

ANNUAL INSTITUTIONAL INSPECTION


The Trust as part of its social and moral obligation undertakes inspection of each of its institutions every year in the months of December-January. Secretary and Trustees of the Trust along with subject experts and Trust Office staff carry out the day-long observations in the Schools / Colleges. The following points are checked without fail.

1. Strength of the School, teacher : student ratio, discipline, results, etc.
2. Progress of the syllabus taught in accordance with the conspectus of studies
3. Feedback from the students regarding the subject taught and manner of teaching
4. Attendance and other records of the teachers and support staff
5. Records and documentation regarding the academic and extra-curricular activities
6. Office management – service registers, leave accounts, stock registers, etc.
7. Account maintenance – cash books, ledgers, vouchers, monthly statements, etc.
8. Library and laboratory maintenance
9. Maintenance of toilets, cleanliness of the campus, etc.
10. Achievements of students in academic and sports activities
11. Working of the mid-day meal scheme
12. Developmental activities carried out or whether needed

The observational report of the Committee is dispatched to the individual Institutions promptly after the inspection. This exercise enables all the stake-holders to reflect upon the achievement and progress of the Institution and act on the shortcomings, if any.

THE KANARA WELFARE TRUST RUN INSTITUTIONS

Dr. Dinkar Desai, a multi-faceted personality - an eminent poet in Kannada, a social worker par excellence and an eminent educationist came like a scourge on the scene of post independent Uttar Kannada District to drive away the illiteracy and ignorance of the people of our district. The intense feeling of empathy for the poor and downtrodden in him resulted in the establishment of the Kanara Welfare Trust in 1953 under the banner of which he founded educational institutions throughout the length and breadth of our district.

Kanara Welfare Trust mainly focuses upon the qualitative basic education, especially in the arena of Primary and High School education. Discipline and high degree of transparency are the salient features of our Trust run institutions. The fact that these institutions are captioned “Janata Vidyalyaya” being established with the co-operation of the rural folk speak volumes of Dr. Dinkar Desai’s organizing skill, his concern for the rural poor who were steeped in mire of wretched poverty in those days and also his conviction that only education can uplift them from the poverty and enable them to enjoy cake of the decent life. The simple structure of the tiled roof of the buildings of the educational institutions in all the rural areas of our district has become a metaphor for simplicity and an inseparable feature of our Uttar Kannada along with the scenic beauty of the hills, the Arabian sea and the cascading waterfalls reflecting the abundant pulchritude of Nature with which our district is surrounded.

In this back drop we endeavour to acquaint you with the Institutions run by the Trust by providing brief information about them.

GOKHALE CENTENARY COLLEGE, ANKOLA



Established in June 1966, the birth centenary year of Gopal Krishna Gokhale, the College is aptly named after him. The College is permanently affiliated to Karnataka University, Dharwad. It has Arts, Science & Commerce faculties leading up to the final year degree courses. The College has an independent building with classrooms and laboratories. It has an Administrative Wing which also houses the Trust Office, an Indoor Games Hall, a Canteen and a Student Consumer Cooperative Society. There are six staff quarters in the campus. There is also a Guest-House in the College premises. The College has well-equipped laboratories in Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology. It has a separate and spacious Library Building named after Dadabhai Naoroji. The College has to its credit many University Blues and rank holders. The College has been re-assessed by NAAC and accredited at the B-level with a CGPA score of 2.85. A new course – M.Sc. in General Chemistry was started in the year 2016-2017.

THAKKAR BAPA HOSTEL, HONNEKERI



This hostel, which was situated at Dandeli, was transferred to Ankola in June 1964. This campus was initially established to provide free boarding and lodging to the poor students of far-off villages. The inmates were admitted to the hostel irrespective of caste or creed. The Trust also provided them with clothing and text-books free of cost. As time progressed, the Govt. started building hostels for students of the backward communities in various places of the district. Slowly, the number of students in our hostel dwindled and the centre ceased functioning. The campus is now rented out to the Smt. Indira Gandhi Residential School and currently houses more than 100 students. New classrooms and additional toilets & bathrooms have been constructed during the year.



Medical Aid in Rural Areas

THE provision of medical aid to the rural population is by far one of the most urgent needs to be met. Voluntary agencies can play an important part in this field by establishing dispensaries and maternity homes. Although our Trust would like to establish a network of such health units in the District, the difficulty in getting doctors cannot be easily overcome.

A rural dispensary was established by the Trust at Bankikodla village in Kumta Taluk in 1959 with the financial help of the Dorabji Tata Trust, to provide allopathic and homeopathic medical treatment to the rural populace of the nearby villages. However, over the passage of time, and due to the availability of modern medical facilities in the Govt. run clinics and hospitals in the rural areas, the centre stopped functioning.

This land at Sarvodaya Nagar, a fisherman colony, near Kodibag, Karwar, housed a Balwadi which was started during 1985-1986 jointly by the N.S.S.
