

It was way back in 1953, that the Kanara Welfare Trust made a tryst with destiny. We are proud that Kanara Welfare Trust has completed 70 years of its useful and fruitful existence. Founder Chairman late Dr. Dinkar Desai wrote in one of his epigrams –

ನಡು ಹಗಲಿನಲ್ಲಿ ನನಗೆ ಬೀಳುವದು ಕನಸು ಈ ಕನಸಿನಿಂದ ಚಿಗುರುವದುಂಟು ಮನಸು ಒಂದೊಂದು ಚಿಗುರಿಗೂ ಒಂದೊಂದು ಶಾಲೆ ಮೂಡಿದರೆ ಶಾರದಾಂಬೆಗೆ ಪುಷ್ಪ ಮಾಲೆ "Right in the middle of the day, I dream and my mind gets inspired by the dream, schools one after the other sprout from my dream Goddess Saraswati gets a garland comprising these schools."

The message of the Trust is very clear. Service is endless. Kanara Welfare Trust is nothing but humanism of Dr. Dinkar Desai personified. Thousands of beneficiaries of the trust living in different places of the District and also outside look up to it with a deep sense of gratitude and wish.

Magnificent buildings, laboratories, libraries and beautiful gardens hold out a proof to the development and activities of the Trust. It should be remembered that the Trust is something more than a collection of bricks and stones. It is a living and growing organisation. Thousands of well-wishers, philanthropic donors, admirers and not to speak of countless beneficiaries constitute this mighty organisation.

By and large, Kanara Welfare Trust has been able to achieve what is contained in the preamble. Observing the manifold activities of the Trust, an eminent person exclaimed, "The Trust by its significant service has almost established a University in the District of North Kanara". Today we have a network of Institutions all over the District. It has to its credit 45 Institutions – 4 Degree colleges, 2 PG Centres, 6 Junior Colleges, 17 High Schools, 10 Primary & Pre-Primary Schools, 2 Tailoring Schools, 2 Music Schools and 2 Computer Centres. It was started with a meagre amount of Rs.6,000 collected by the Raith Community and now the assets are more than 15 crores excluding the land. The family of the Trust is growing day by day and there has been a significant increase in the number of students. Total enrolment is about 9000. All these have been possible because of the careful and judicious management of the Trust.

Saga of Kanara Welfare Trust is the saga of sacrifice of one individual – Dr. Dinkar Desai – who was our great torch bearer and lent us all help to keep this torch burning and spread the light in to the farthest corners of the District. Since the death of Dr. Desai in 1982, the present Chairman, Shri S.P.Kamat is contributing his mite to keep the torch bright and blazing aloft. He is ably assisted by the other Trustees. The Trust has been conducting fresh and feasible experiments in the welfare of the people of this district from time to time under his dynamic leadership.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE TRUST

- a. To carry out and promote educational, cultural, social and material advancement of the people, particularly of the backward and poorer classes within the District of Uttar Kannada.
- b. To impart education and knowledge, especially by establishing and maintaining educational institutions and hostels, including agricultural schools, teacher training schools and schools for imparting technical education.
- c. To establish Institutions of higher learning in medical, engineering, pharmaceutical and in any other branch of social relevance.
- d. To establish hospitals, dispensaries with emphasis on holistic treatment.
- e. To publish books of literary merit.
- f. To set up old-age and destitute homes, orphanages and / or to encourage and help Institutions / individuals engaged in similar pursuits for the benefit of the public at large.
- g. To undertake research and development in any field which may be conducive for the general welfare of the public at large.
- h. To help preservation and protection of the environment and forests.
- i. To evolve models / systems of bio-conservation, Indian and world eco-structure, etc.
- j. To establish laboratories, training centres, knowledge centres, etc.
- k. To encourage the learning and spreading of Indian culture and heritage, such as music, fine art, literature, etc.
- I. For the furtherance of the objectives to maintain liaison with other professional institutions and training bodies in various parts of the world.
- m. To act in collaboration with Central and State Governments and other bodies or appropriate agencies for formulation and executions of the project which would further the objectives as set out above and to accept any grants or funds and donations for the said purpose.
- n. To act as a clearing house of information for various individuals, institutions or other persons interested in the activities listed above.
- o. To promote the publication of literature pertaining to the objectives and the activities contemplated herein.
- p. To establish and maintain liaison with other associations or recognized bodies in India or abroad whose objectives are in keeping with the objectives of this Trust.
- q. To purchase, to take on lease or in exchange or otherwise acquire, hold, possess and dispose of any movable or immovable property which may be deemed necessary, expedient or desirable in the larger interest of the Trust and its objectives.
- r. To enter into arrangements / amalgamation with any other associations, institutions, societies or trusts having similar objectives as of this Trust.

- s. To borrow money or receive deposits upon such terms and conditions as the Board shall deem necessary or expedient for achieving the objectives of this Trust.
- t. To give any donations or aid to any other deserving, charitable institutions or to a cause or to any needy / deserving person / persons as may be found suitable by the Board.
- u. To undertake the acts of whatever nature which are consistent with the objectives herein and / or which may promote the objectives herein, and are also conducive for the welfare and well-being of the people at large.

It has been a long journey for Kanara Welfare Trust since its inception in 1953. Though started as an educational Institution to spread the seed of education among the rural populace, the Trust has transcended its boundaries and is now actively making strides in the field of primary health care and social welfare.

I have had the privilege of observing first-hand the efforts of the Trust's founder, Dr. Dinkar Desai, since I started my service in 1966 at Gokhale Centenrary College, Ankola. A determined man, Dr. Desai left no stone unturned to create a network of schools & colleges across the length and breadth of this forest district of Uttar Kannada. He was ably supported by his then fellow Trustees in this noble endeavour. The main aim at that time was to provide basic education to the masses at a time where there were no Govt. schools in the vicinity.

Kanara Welfare Trust has more than addressed the need of providing Primary, High School & College Education to the people of this district. Dr. Dinkar Desai's legacy has continued unabated. With the change at the helm of affairs, there has also been a subtle transformation in the activities of the Trust. Our present Chairman, Shri S.P.Kamat, has contributed immensely to take the Trust in a new direction. He has brought in new ideas and resources to facilitate novel projects and schemes, which are being executed by the Trust. Through innovative schemes such as Project Change Makers for a Better Tomorrow, Lecture Series by eminent personalities, District Level Debate Competitions, Financial Assistance for Education, Mobile Health Care, etc. the Trust has been reaching out to the students and people in need from all strata of society. Under the able guidance and leadership of Shri S.P.Kamat, the Trust has established a name for itself on account of its transparency and ethical principles.

In the course of years, the Trust has made optimum use of its resources and modern technology. We have our own website (www.kwtankola.com) which provides information on the various activities of the Trust. Our Schools and Colleges are equipped with computers and audio-visual technology which aid in learning. Remedial coaching is provided to academically weaker students. In-house refresher & orientation workshops are organized for the faculty and staff with expert resource persons in attendance. Annual Inspections are carried out to gauze the quality of education in all our Institutions and any shortfall is adequately addressed. A meeting of all the Heads of the Trust Institutions is organized every year to enable the Management and Institutions to interact with each other and chalk out the action plan for the year. Developmental activities, repairs & maintenance of existing facilities are promptly undertaken. Achievers among the faculty and student community are honoured timely.

Due to the Covid-19 situation and with the restrictions in place, most of our student centric and socio-cultural activities could not take place for the last 2-3 years. We are hoping to recommence all our activities shortly from this academic year onwards. We seek the cooperation and support of all the stakeholders.

The Trust has been managing presently more than 45 Institutions all over the district. The workload on the office staff has been continuously increasing due to several factors. As per the earlier deed, five Trustees were supposed to manage the Trust and give directions for the administration. One of the Trustees, Shri G.V.Bhat, expired on 31-12-2022. Another Trustee, Smt. Usha Pradhan, who was a member of the Board since 1983, resigned from the Trusteeship on 19-03-2023.

It was felt necessary and appropriate that the number of Trustees need to be increased from 5 to 7 to accommodate more Trustees who can take additional responsibilities and give proper direction for the administration of the Trust. Under the circumstances, the present Trustees unanimously decided to increase the number of Trustees from 5 to 7 and provide for more representation in the Board of Trustees.

Consequent to the amendment of the Trust Deed, and deliberations in the subsequent meetings of the Board of Trustees, the following persons were coopted as Trustees of Kanara Welfare Trust.

Shri Prashant N Rao, who was working as Special Coordinator of Kanara Welfare Trust, was appointed as Joint Secretary of the Trust.

The beneficiaries under this scheme for the period 2019-2023 are as under.



THE KANARA WELFARE TRUST RUN INSTITUTIONS



Dr. Dinkar Desai, a multi-faceted personality - an eminent poet in Kannada, a social worker par excellence and an eminent educationist came like a scourge on the scene of post independent Uttar Kannada District to drive away the illiteracy and ignorance of the people of our district. The intense feeling of empathy for the poor and downtrodden in him resulted in the establishment of the Kanara Welfare Trust in 1953 under the banner of which he founded educational institutions throughout the length and breadth of our district.

Kanara Welfare Trust mainly focuses upon the qualitative basic education, especially in the arena of Primary and High School education. Discipline and high degree of transparency are the salient features of our Trust run institutions. The fact that these institutions are captioned "Janata Vidyalaya" and were established with the co-operation of the rural folk speak volumes of Dr. Dinkar Desai's organizing skill, his concern for the rural poor who were steeped in the mire of wretched poverty in those days and also his conviction that only education can uplift them from poverty and enable them to enjoy the cake of the decent life. The simple structure of the tiled roof of the buildings of the educational institutions in all the rural areas of our district has become a metaphor for simplicity and an inseparable feature of our Uttar Kannada along with the scenic beauty of the hills, the rivers, the Arabian sea and the cascading waterfalls reflecting the abundant pulchritude of Nature with which our district is surrounded.

With this backdrop, we endeavour to acquaint you with the Institutions run by the Trust by providing brief information about them.

GOKHALE CENTENARY COLLEGE, ANKOLA



Established in June 1966, the birth centenary year of Gopal Krishna Gokhale, the College is aptly named after him. The College is permanently affiliated to Karnataka University, Dharwad. It has Arts, Science & Commerce faculties leading up to the final year degree courses. M.Sc. in General Chemistry was started in the year 2016-2017. The College has an independent building with classrooms and laboratories. It has an Administrative Wing, which also houses the Trust Office, an Indoor Games Hall, a Canteen and a Student Consumer Cooperative Society. There are six staff quarters in the campus along with the Chairman's Quarters. There is also a Guest-House in the College premises. The College has well-equipped laboratories in Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology and Computer Science. It has a separate and spacious Library Building named after Dadabhai Naoroji. The College has to its credit many University Blues and rank holders. The College has been recently reassessed by NAAC and accredited with A+ grade [CGPA score of 3.34].



THAKKAR BAPA HOSTEL, HONNEKERI



This hostel, which was situated at Dandeli, was transferred to Ankola in June 1964. This campus was initially established to provide free boarding and lodging to the poor students of far-off villages. The inmates were admitted to the hostel irrespective of caste or creed. The Trust also provided them with clothing and text-books free of cost. As time progressed, the Govt. started building hostels for students of the backward communities in various places of the district. Slowly, the number of students in our hostel dwindled and the centre ceased functioning. The campus is now rented out to the Smt. Medical Aid in Rural Areas

THE provision of medical aid to the rural population is by far one of the most urgent needs to be met. Voluntary agencies can play an important part in this field by establishing dispensaries and maternity homes. Although our Trust would like to establish a network of such health units in the District, the difficulty in getting doctors cannot be easily overcome.



A rural dispensary was established by the Trust at Bankikodla village in Kumta Taluk in 1959 with the financial help of the Dorabji Tata Trust, to provide allopathic and homeopathic medical treatment to the rural populace of the nearby villages. However, over the passage of time, and due to the availability of modern medical facilities in the

Govt. run clinics and hospitals in the rural areas, the centre stopped functioning.

This land at Sarvodaya Nagar, a fisherman colony, near Kodibag, Karwar, housed a Balwadi which was started during 1985-1986 jointly by the N.S.S. Unit of Divekar College of Commerce, Karwar and Shri Satya Sai Samiti, Kodibag. The Trust took over this School in November 1989 following a request by the Balawadi Development Committee. However, over the course of time, it was closed down due to lack of students. It is now rented out to a self-help group of Kodibag, Karwar.
